

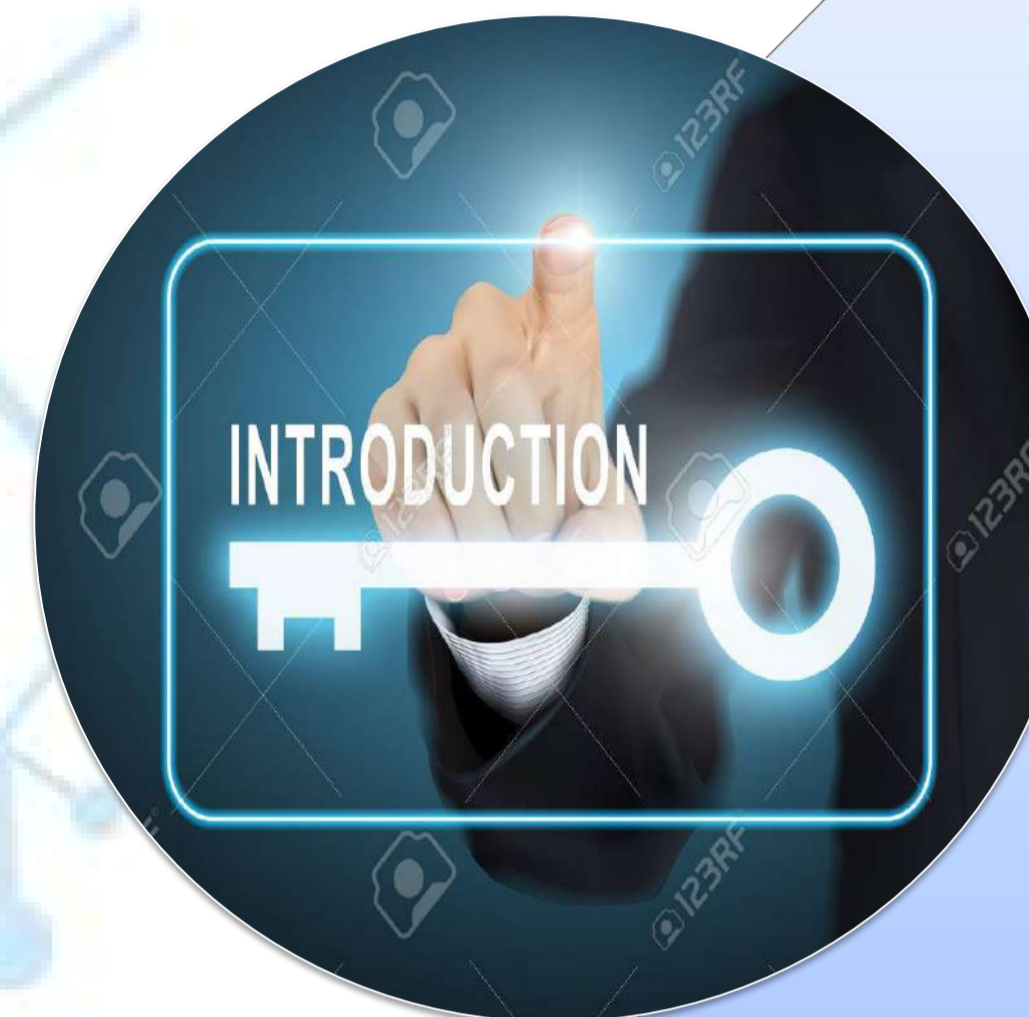
BIOETHICAL DIMENSION OF THE PHENOMENON OF MEDICAL STAFF INFECTION WITH COVID-19

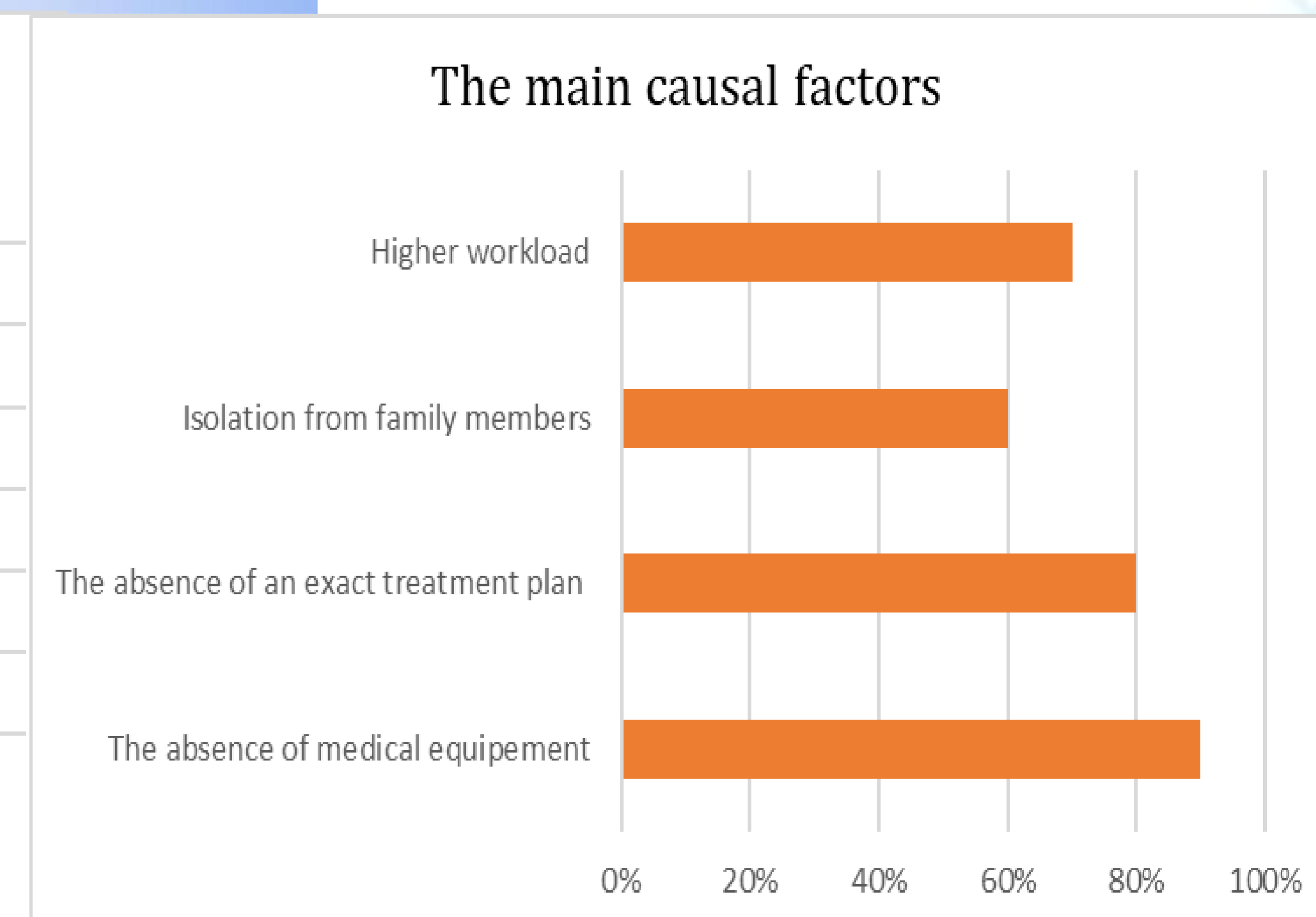
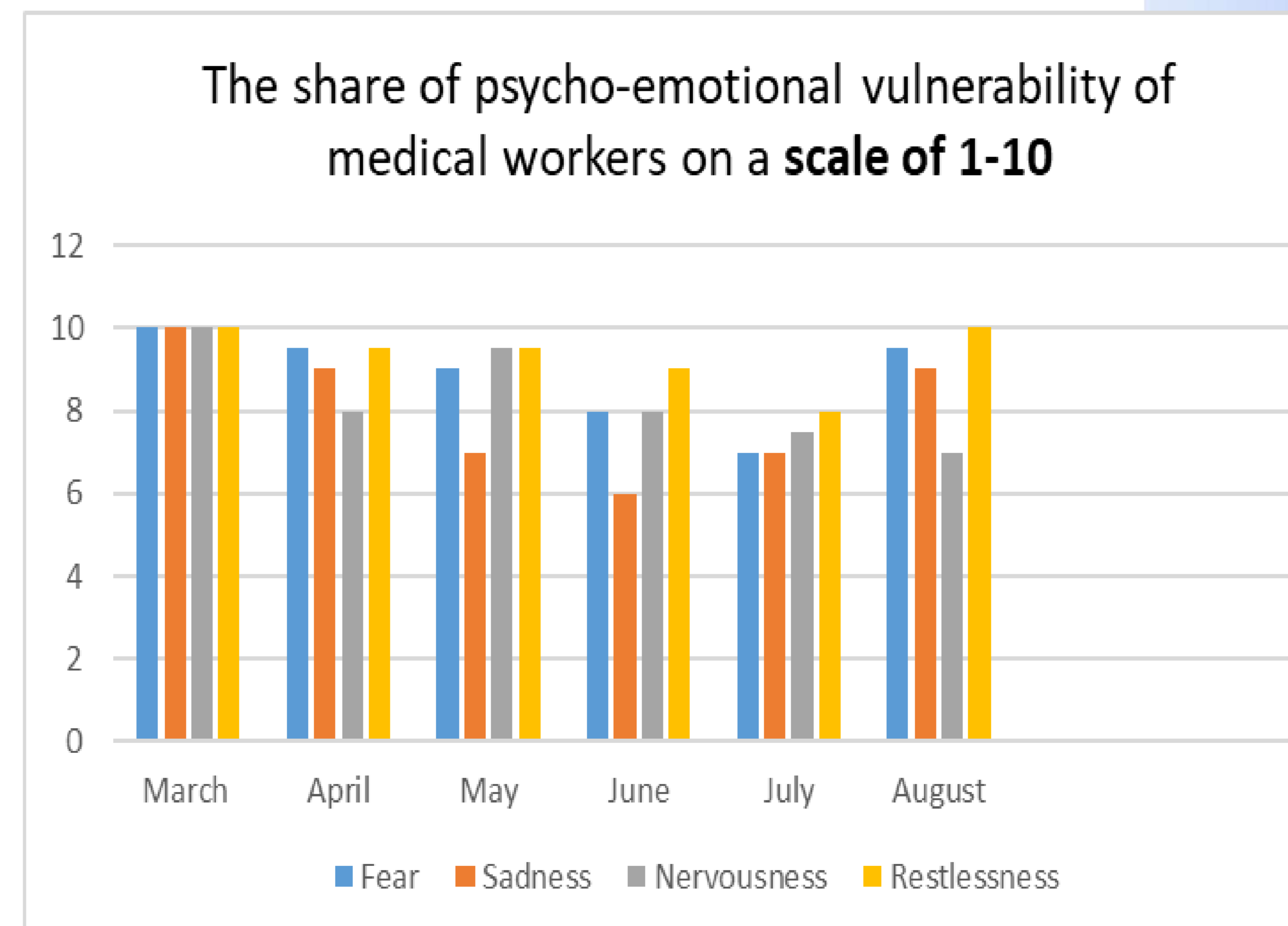


Purpose
