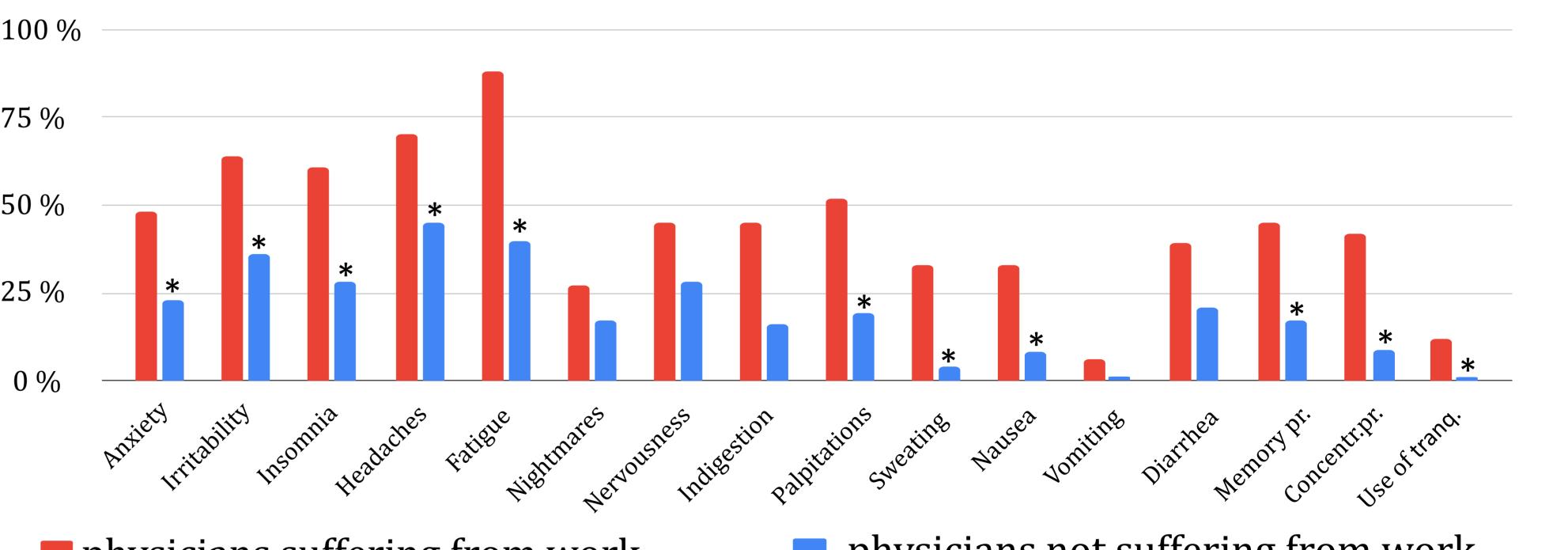

Work-related stress negatively affects anesthesiologists' and intensive care physicians' health, and it is necessary to take steps to reduce stress in the workplace.



anesthesiologists and intensive care physicians (41%) from work-related stress. They more frequently red erienced anxiety (p=0.030), irritability (p=0.023), insomnia (0.005), headaches (p=0.039), fatigue (p<0.001), palpitations (002), excessive sweating (p=0.007), and nausea (p=0.008). results of our study showed that physicians suffering from k-related stress more frequently had memory problems .014), concentration problems (p<0.001), and more uently consumed tranquilizers (p=0.026)(Fig.1).
